THIS CAUSE having been heard on the Motion of the Board of Supervisors of the Bermont Drainage District to extend the corporate existence of said District from March 13, 1995; and the Court finding that the Bermont Drainage District was created by that certain Final Decree Creating and Incorporating Drainage District which was entered in the above-styled cause on March 12, 1965; which said Final Decree granted an initial thirty-year corporate existence for said Drainage District; which said Final Decree created and established a Drainage District within the boundaries of the following described real property located in Charlotte County, Florida,

to-wit:

TOWNSHIP 40 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST
